### **Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Supervise members and guests using pool and pool area
- Instruct Red Cross Learn To Swim Programs and Lifesaving Swim Patrol and Bronze Levels
- Maintain the pool area to ensure the facility is safe and clean
- Ensure the safety of all members and guests while in the pool facility
- Record water readings at the defined intervals; perform pool cleaning functions
- Enforce Pool Rules and Regulations and adhere to Public Health Regulation 565
- Communicate efficiently with Aquatics Coordinator and Head Lifeguard regarding sanitary or mechanical issues
- Provide a safe, enjoyable experience for all members and fellow staff
- Represent the Club professionally at all times
- Participate in meetings, staff training, and Club events
- Additional duties and responsibilities as assigned

### **Job Requirements:**

- Acceptable combination of education, training and experience
- Possess a current NLS Award; Red Cross Water Safety Instructor Certification; Lifesaving Instructors Award; Current Standard First Aid Certification with CPR (Level C) and Current AED certification
- (LSS Swim Instructors can be updated to Red Cross for the certification fee)
- Advanced Aquatic leadership Awards as applicable – Aquatic Supervisor Training; Examiners Status; First Aid Instructor/Examiner; etc. would be highly encouraged.
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills
- Demonstrated leadership skills, including the ability to motivate swimmers of various levels
- Responsible and organized with the ability to multi-task
